ORDER

On October 22, 2025, Appellants filed a motion for limited remand, seeking an order from this court remanding the matter for the limited purpose of allowing Appellants to file a motion pursuant to Rule 60(b)(4) of the South Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure. On December 30, 2025, this court denied the motion for limited remand and ordered Appellants' initial brief and designation of matter to be served and filed within ten days of the date of the order.

On January 9, 2026, Appellants filed their initial brief and designation of matter. On January 30, 2026, Respondent filed a motion to (1) strike arguments I.a and I.b of Appellants' initial brief on the basis the existence of the arguments violated this court's December 30, 2025 order and (2) stay deadlines until the court rules on her motion to strike. Appellants filed a return, opposing the motion to strike. Respondent filed a reply.

After careful consideration, we deny the motion to strike without determining the propriety of the arguments in I.a and I.b. Respondent shall serve and file her initial brief and designation of matter within fifteen days of the date of this order.
