1. I was appointed by the Clerk of Court to handle the above referenced matter for Emanuelle Hargrove, Jr. This appeal is part of a guilty plea on January 8, 2026 in Jasper County, South Carolina before the Honorable Robert J. Bonds.
2. A Motion to Reconsider Sentence was filed on this matter on January 16, 2026, with the Beaufort County General Sessions Court Clerk of Court.
3. The Honorable Robert J. Bonds denied my motion to reconsider sentence on March 5, 2026, in the Jasper County General Sessions Court.
4. I am an Assistant Public Defender with the Fourteenth Circuit Public Defender's Office and a licensed attorney with the South Carolina Bar.
5. I am filing this appeal upon the request of my client, Emanuelle Hargrove, Jr.
6. There is a reviewable appellate issue in that Mr. Hargrove was denied pre-sentence jail credit for 547 days under The South Carolina Code Section 24-13-40, which became effective June 20, 2023. At the request of appellant, I am filing this appeal.





Unlawfully Store or Possess Machine Gun or Firearm




