**RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO DENY APPELLANT'S MOTION TO SERVE  
AND FILE OUT OF TIME  
AND MOTION TO DISMISS APPEAL FOR FAILURE TO PROSECUTE**

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## **STATEMENT OF THE CASE**

This appeal arises from a civil action involving real property located at 5554 Rosebank Road, Wadmalaw Island, South Carolina 29487. The Notice of Appeal was filed on November 12, 2024.

Since the filing of the appeal, the docket reflects repeated procedural deficiencies, corrections, motions for extension of time, and motions to allow late filings by the Appellant. Despite multiple opportunities to comply with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, the Record on Appeal has not been timely served and filed.

Correspondence from the Court dated February 6, 2026 and February 9, 2026 confirms that the Record on Appeal is overdue. Respondent therefore moves the Court to deny the Appellant's Motion to Serve and File the Record on Appeal Out of Time and dismiss the appeal for failure to prosecute pursuant to Rule 210(c) and Rule 240 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.

## **PROCEDURAL HISTORY AND PATTERN OF DELAY**

The Notice of Appeal was filed on November 12, 2024. Since that time, the docket reflects numerous deficiency letters issued by the Court requiring corrections to filings including the Notice of Appeal, motions filed by the Appellant, transcript correspondence, the Appellant's Initial Brief, the Designation of Matter, and the Appellant's Reply Brief.

The Appellant also filed multiple motions requesting extensions of time and motions to allow late filings. The Court granted certain extensions and permitted corrections to filings; however, the appeal has continued to involve repeated deficiencies and delays.

Most significantly, the Court issued correspondence on February 6, 2026 and again on February 9, 2026 indicating that the Record on Appeal remains overdue.

## **FAILURE TO TIMELY SERVE AND FILE THE RECORD ON APPEAL**

The Record on Appeal is the foundation of appellate review because it provides the Court with the materials necessary to evaluate the issues raised in the appeal.

Rule 210(c) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules provides that if the appellant fails to serve and file the Record on Appeal within the time prescribed by the rules, the appeal may be dismissed for failure to prosecute.

Despite the passage of more than a year since the Notice of Appeal was filed and despite prior extensions and opportunities to correct deficiencies, the Record on Appeal has not been timely served and filed and has been identified by the Court as overdue.

Respondent respectfully submits that continued extensions under these circumstances would undermine the orderly administration of appellate review and further delay final resolution of the case.

### **OPPOSITION TO APPELLANT'S MOTION TO SERVE AND FILE OUT OF TIME**

Respondent respectfully opposes the Appellant's Motion to Serve and File the Record on Appeal Out of Time.

The Appellant attributes the delay to travel related to a family medical matter. Respondent acknowledges the personal circumstances described in the motion and expresses sympathy for any hardship involved.

However, the procedural delays reflected in the docket began long before the circumstances described in the motion and demonstrate a continuing pattern of deficient filings, corrections, and missed deadlines.

### **PREJUDICE AND UNDUE FINANCIAL BURDEN TO RESPONDENT**

The property at issue, located at 5554 Rosebank Road, Wadmalaw Island, South Carolina 29487, remains encumbered by a lis pendens during the pendency of this appeal.

Respondent has been solely responsible for all financial obligations associated with the property, including payment of the mortgage, property taxes, insurance, and necessary repairs both prior to the underlying litigation and throughout the entire appellate process.

The continued delay in prosecuting this appeal imposes an ongoing financial burden upon Respondent while preventing Respondent from fully exercising ownership rights over the property.

### **REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF LIS PENDENS**

Because this appeal concerns real property owned by Respondent and a lis pendens has been recorded against the property, Respondent respectfully requests that upon dismissal of this appeal the Court order that the lis pendens affecting the property located at 5554 Rosebank Road, Wadmalaw Island, South Carolina 29487 be cancelled and released of record.

### **PRAYER FOR RELIEF**

WHEREFORE, Respondent Florence Heyward Davis respectfully requests that this Court:

1. Deny the Appellant's Motion to Serve and File the Record on Appeal Out of Time;

2. Dismiss the appeal for failure to prosecute pursuant to Rule 210(c) and Rule 240 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules;
3. Order the cancellation and release of any lis pendens affecting the property located at 5554 Rosebank Road, Wadmalaw Island, South Carolina 29487; and
4. Grant such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.

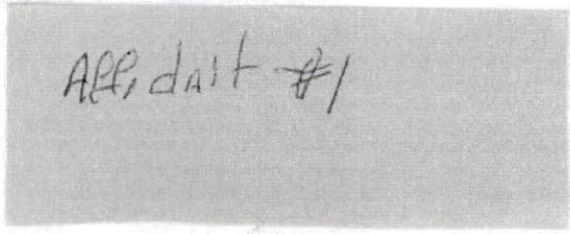

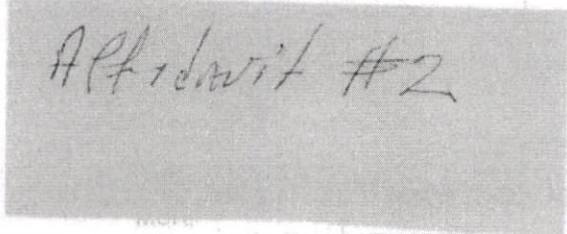
