
Defendants/Appellants are indigent and unable to pay filing fees and costs.





1. My current monthly income: \$0 I was laid off my job from The Greenville Housing Authority as a Senior Coordinator due to restructuring. I have been looking for work and applying but I'm not getting any calls due to the state of the economy.
2. I am also not currently employed due to ongoing legal and housing displacement.
3. My business is not generating income at this time as a Master's Level Mental Health/Life Coach Therapist.
4. My monthly expenses include:
 - Food: I was receiving \$200 in food stamps. I am no longer receiving them.
 - Transportation: Car is in repossession status.
 - Phone: Phone is currently disconnected.
 - Medical or emergency expenses: I am suffering from sciatica nerve pain and other medical issues.
 - Other basic necessities:
5. I do not have sufficient savings or assets to pay the \$150 appeal fee.
6. I am displaced after the sale of my home of 11 years.
7. I am facing harassment, bullying, and safety concerns that limit my ability to maintain employment.
8. Payment of court fees would prevent me from obtaining relief and deny me access to the judicial process.

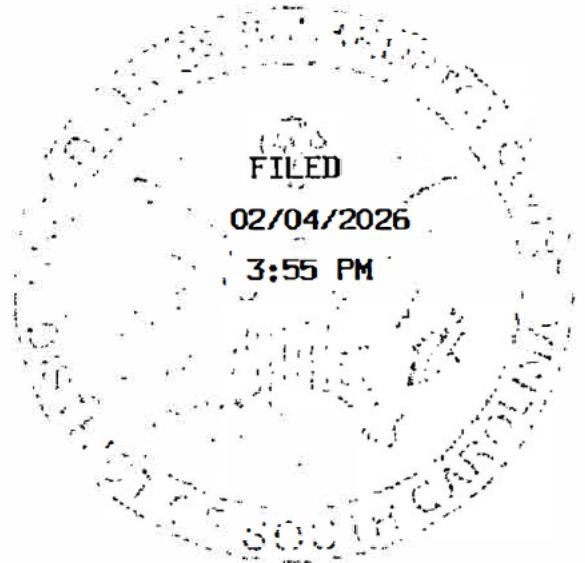

HARDSHIP STATEMENT

To the Honorable Circuit Court Judge:

I am requesting a fee waiver because I am experiencing severe financial hardship. I am displaced, have no stable housing, and currently have no income. The Magistrate Court denied me due process by refusing to review my documentation, photographs, video recordings, and supporting evidence.

I cannot access justice unless this Court allows me to proceed without fees.

I am appealing because the Magistrate Judge's actions caused serious prejudice, including:

- Refusal to allow me to present evidence
- Allowing intimidation by opposing parties
- Inappropriate comments
- Biased treatment
- Court starting 1½ hours late
- Failure to review documentation proving land and camper and land rights

I am a long-term partner of 28 years to Derrick Brown. We were displaced after the landlord sold the home we lived in for 11 years. I have no family or support system in Laurens, and I am facing ongoing harassment from individuals connected to my case.

Requiring me to pay filing fees would deny my constitutional right to a fair appeal.

I respectfully ask the Court to approve my fee waiver.

EMERGENCY HARDSHIP STATEMENT

SC Court of Appeals

Submitted by: Faith Walker (on behalf of Derrick Brown)

I submit this statement to explain the severe and urgent hardship that the court's actions have caused for me and my husband, Derrick Brown.

1. Imminent Homelessness

We were displaced after living in our prior home for 11 years. The Magistrate Court's rulings have placed us at immediate risk of homelessness, with no available housing alternatives.

2. Unsafe Living Conditions

We are currently living in a camper with:

- No running water
- No electricity
- No heat
- No stability

These conditions are dangerous, especially during winter.

3. Forced Contact With Aggressors

The bond order requires us to:

- Travel to the home of individuals who have assaulted and harassed us
- Sign payment receipts in their presence
- Risk our appeal being dismissed if we refuse. This is unsafe and places our physical and emotional wellbeing at risk.

4. Financial Hardship

I am indigent.

My appeal fee had to be waived. I cannot afford forced "rent" payments based on Google campground rates. We cannot comply with orders requiring money we do not have.

5. Mental and Emotional Harm

This process has caused:

- Severe anxiety
- Sleeplessness
- Fear for my personal safety
- Feeling targeted and retaliated against

6. Weaponization of the Court System

Derrick's parents initiated this eviction not because of any legal reason but out of personal dislike for me.

The court enabling this retaliatory eviction has worsened our hardship.

7. Requested Emergency Relief

I respectfully request:

- Immediate review
- Intervention to stop unsafe bond orders
- Dismissal of the fraudulent eviction
- Protection from forced contact with individuals who have harmed us
- Oversight to ensure due process and fairness in the appeal

UNSWORN DECLARATION OF SEVERE HARDSHIP, DISPLACEMENT, TITLE WITHHOLDING, AND EMERGENCY CIRCUMSTANCES (UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY)

I, Faith Walker and DerrickBrown, declare under penalty of perjury pursuant to the laws of the State of South Carolina that the following is true and correct:

1. I am a Defendant/Appellant in Laurens County Magistrate Court Case No. 2025CV301012867 and Circuit Court Case No. 2025-CP-30-1380.
2. As a direct result of the dismissal of our appeal and enforcement of the Writ of Ejectment, I was displaced and rendered homeless.
3. The displacement was sudden and occurred after the appeal was dismissed based on alleged nonpayment of a bond that I was financially unable to pay due to indigency.
4. I borrowed money to make the January 5, 2026 payment in good faith. I obtained funds and attempted to pay again on or about February 9, 2026, but payment was refused.
5. Following enforcement, I was required to secure emergency lodging at a hotel for approximately ten (10) days.
6. The hotel did not allow pets, which required separate arrangements for the dogs, including kennel or temporary placement.
7. The emergency hotel stay, kennel costs, towing expenses, and relocation costs created severe financial hardship.
8. I was forced to seek bankruptcy protection due to the financial instability and emergency expenses caused by displacement.
9. Plaintiffs/Respondents demanded removal of the camper within a limited time period but refused to provide the camper title necessary for lawful relocation.
10. Without the title, relocation of the camper was obstructed, creating an impossible situation.

11. Plaintiffs/Respondents retained access to the camper, including possession of a key, creating insecurity and risk of interference with belongings.



13. The cumulative effect of these actions has resulted in homelessness, severe hardship, emotional distress, and ongoing instability.





For the past 11 years, Derrick and I

This situation is a family property
dispute rather than a typical landlord-
tenant matter. Derrick paid his father
Rufus Brown a lump sum of money
with a verbal agreement to have his
camper situated on the land in 2021,
yet his parents are withholding the
camper title.

With three dogs in my care and no
alternative accommodation available,
the enforcement of the writ would
result in immediate homelessness for
me and our fur babies. On January
22, 2026 I mailed in emergency
motions pertaining to this matter
because I was told that I couldn't file
motions in person continuing not to
allow me due process in this case. I
still haven't heard anything yet.

I humbly implore for an emergency
stay of eviction and kindly request a
waiver of all associated fees. I have
reattached my motions for your
review, emphasizing the urgency of
the situation.
