Motion For Supersedeas
Of Court Judgment

Pursuant to Rule 241 S.C.A.R., Appellant moves this Court for an order staying the judgment of the Court for the following reasons:


- ① The judgment of the Court has subjected me to paying ~~Attorney~~ fees to Respondent and I was not allowed to attend the final hearing to challenge such;
- ② The judgment of the Court was challenged under Rule 59(e) S.C.R.C.P. due to the fact that Respondents failed to file denials to averments within defensive pleadings subjecting themselves to the provisions of Rule 8(d) S.C.R.C.P.;
- ③ The judgment of the Court has subjected me to a fraudulent conveyance of real property. Respondents breached an Oral Purchase-sell agreement we had prior to the commencement of the original complaint. The Court failed to afford me an adequate opportunity to present this fact, prompting me to file a rule 60(b) S.C.R.C.P. motion.

④ The judgment of the lower court is originally unstayable by the filing of the notice of appeal. Allowing the judgment of the lower court to be executed would significantly prejudice Appellant and subject him to an extreme mis-carriage of justice.
