NOTICE OF LODGMENT AND REQUEST FOR JUDICIAL NOTICE

(Filed Concurrently with Supplemental Lodgment: Equitable Bill of Revocation of Trust and Demand for Accounting

COMES NOW Samuel Tucker Collins, Jr., the living man, appearing in his own proper person, and hereby files this Notice of Lodgment and Request for Judicial Notice in the above-captioned miscellaneous docket.

I. LODGMENT OF DOCUMENTS

1. Petitioner hereby lodges with this Court the following documents, filed concurrently herewith:

- a. **Supplemental Lodgment: Equitable Bill of Revocation of Trust and Demand for Accounting** (the "Revocation Document"), together with all exhibits attached thereto;
- b. **Petitioner's Response to Court Order and Clarification of Proceeding** (filed March 13, 2026);
- c. **Petitioner's Local Rule 26.01 Answers to Interrogatories** (filed March 13, 2026).

2. These documents are lodged as part of the permanent record in this miscellaneous docket, ancillary to Petitioner's pending state court proceedings.

II. REQUEST FOR JUDICIAL NOTICE UNDER RULE 201

3. Petitioner respectfully requests that this Court, and any court or tribunal in which these facts may become relevant, take **judicial notice** of the following facts and documents pursuant to Federal Rule of Evidence 201:

- a. The existence and contents of the Revocation Document and its exhibits, as filed in this miscellaneous docket;
- b. The existence and contents of Petitioner's **Plea of Release and Equitable Tender** (Dkt. No. 5), filed February 26, 2026, in this docket;

- c. The existence and contents of Petitioner's **Response to Court Order and Clarification of Proceeding** (filed March 13, 2026);
 - d. The existence and contents of Petitioner's **Local Rule 26.01 Answers to Interrogatories** (filed March 13, 2026);
 - e. The existence and contents of all exhibits attached to the foregoing documents.
4. These facts are capable of accurate and ready determination from sources whose accuracy cannot reasonably be questioned, as they derive from:
 - o Official records of this Court;
 - o Official records of the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission;
 - o Official CUSIP reports from recognized financial data sources;
 - o Certified copies of state court orders and filings.
 5. Under Rule 201(c)(2), a court **must** take judicial notice if requested by a party and supplied with the necessary information. Petitioner has supplied the necessary information through the filings referenced herein.

III. SELF-AUTHENTICATION UNDER RULE 902

6. The documents referenced herein, once filed and bearing the file stamp and seal of this Court, are **self-authenticating** under Federal Rule of Evidence 902(1) and (4).
7. Specifically:
 - o **Rule 902(1)** : Documents bearing the seal of a United States court require no extrinsic evidence of authenticity;
 - o **Rule 902(4)** : Certified copies of public records are self-authenticating.
8. Certified copies of these documents, when obtained from the Clerk of this Court, may be presented in any forum without further proof of authenticity.

IV. PURPOSE AND EFFECT

9. This Notice is filed to ensure that all parties and tribunals are aware that:
 - a. The facts alleged in Petitioner's filings are matters of public record in this Court;
 - b. Those facts are subject to judicial notice under Rule 201;
 - c. The documents themselves are self-authenticating under Rule 902;

d. Any party proceeding in ignorance of these facts does so at their own risk, with actual notice.

10. This Notice is also filed to create a clear record that Petitioner has complied with all procedural requirements and has given all parties ample opportunity to respond.

V. NOTICE TO ALL PARTIES

11. All parties to the underlying state proceedings, including but not limited to those listed in the Certificate of Service below, are hereby notified that:

- a. The Revocation Document and its exhibits have been lodged in this federal miscellaneous docket;
- b. The facts contained therein are now matters of public record;
- c. This Court has been requested to take judicial notice of those facts;
- d. Silence or failure to respond shall be deemed acquiescence.

VI. RESERVATION OF RIGHTS


12. Petitioner expressly reserves all rights under UCC 1-308 and applicable law.
