Dear Counsel:

We have received a Notice of Appeal from each of you in the above matter. Unless notified by you to the contrary, these appeals will be consolidated for consideration by the Court under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, and we anticipate receiving one Record on Appeal.

In this consolidated appeal, the party filing the first Notice of Appeal, Edward D. Sullivan, has been designated as the primary appellant, called Appellant/Respondent, and is responsible for serving and filing the Record on Appeal. The parties filing the second Notice of Appeal, Martha Brown and Mary Moses, have been designated as the secondary appellants, called Respondents/Appellants.

Under Appellate Court Rules 206 and 207, Appellant/Respondent must order the transcript within ten (10) days after the date of service of the Notice of Appeal.

Appellant/Respondent shall notify this Court in writing as soon as the transcript is delivered by the court reporter. All Appellant's Initial Briefs and Designations of Matter will be due thirty (30) days from the date the Appellant/Respondent receives the transcript.

The briefing schedule for both appeals shall be as set forth in Appellate Court Rules 208 and 209. Each party is allowed to serve and file an Initial Appellant's Brief along with Designation of Matter to be included in the Record on Appeal, a Respondent's Brief, and a Reply Brief.

In order to avoid any unnecessary delays in this appeal, the title of the briefs should state exactly what document is being filed and exactly which party is filing it. For example:

Appellant's Initial Brief of Respondent-Appellant Mary Moses, or,  
Respondent's Final Brief of Appellant-Respondent Edward D. Sullivan.

All parties are advised that the case caption has been amended to read as follows:

In the Matter of the Estate of Marion M. Kay

Edward D. Sullivan, as Personal Representative of the Estate of Marion M. Kay,  
Appellant-Respondent,

v.

Martha Brown and Mary Moses, Respondents-Appellants.
