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1           THE CLERK: Raise your right hand. Do  
2 you solemnly swear or affirm to tell the truth,  
3 the whole truth, and nothing but the truth?

4           MR. SIMPSON: Yes, ma'am.

5           THE CLERK: Thank you.

6           THE COURT: Sir, you are Christopher  
7 David Simpson?

8           MR. SIMPSON: Yes, sir.

9           THE COURT: Mr. Simpson, have you read or  
10 had read to your report of your alleged probation  
11 violation?

12          MR. SIMPSON: Yes, sir.

13          THE COURT: You understand why you are

23 release papers when I received them. From what I  
24 understand from what's on-line or seen on-line, it  
25 was a money situation, it was a non-report

1 probation.

2 As far as my address, my address is the  
3 same. My home phone number has been the same.

4 I paid the probation up -- paid up -- paid it  
5 off.

6 THE COURT: Tell me, what's this about he  
7 beat the victim again?

8 AGENT COOPER: It's a separate victim,  
9 Your Honor. If I could just -- bear with me, Your  
10 Honor.

11 THE COURT: Yes, please.

12 AGENT COOPER: He had a partial  
13 revocation in 2021. He served a five-year partial  
14 revocation. He was released from SCDC. He didn't  
15 report upon release. I went out and made contact  
16 with him in December of last year. At that point,  
17 he tested positive for illegal narcotics. I  
18 arrested him.

19 The first step is go to an administrative  
20 hearing. We are going forward to put him in some  
21 kind of treatment facility. He failed to show up  
22 to the administrative hearing.

23 I went to his house again. I couldn't  
24 make contact. I exhausted all avenues at that  
25 point.

1                   Another warrant was issued.  Consequently, in  
2                   June 10th, he was arrested by Anderson County  
3                   Sheriff's Office for a new domestic violence 2nd  
4                   degree.

5                   THE COURT:  The same victim?

6                   AGENT COOPER:  A different victim.

7                   I have received paperwork for an  
8                   affidavit withdrawing the criminal complaint.  
9                   That's not what we're interested in.

10                  We issued a warrant because of our DV  
11                  conditions.  Harassment is a component of that.

12                  So June 10th -- he's been incarcerated  
13                  since June 10th.  He barely reported.  He missed  
14                  his admin.  And if he wanted to get clean and get  
15                  substance abuse counseling, he would have showed  
16                  up to the admin and that's what we were looking  
17                  for originally.

18                  THE COURT:  All right.  Thank you, sir.

19                  AGENT COOPER:  Thank you.

20                  MR. BRADLEY:  May it please the Court?  Your  
21                  Honor, exactly what Agent Cooper just said.  
22                  Mr. Simpson is seeking a residential facility.  As he  
23                  said, he's paid all his money off.  He already served  
24                  six-and-a-half years towards the largest sentence.  
25                  He's already completed the other two; possession of

1 meth charge and unlawful possession of a sawed-off  
2 shotgun. He's already maxed those out and it should  
3 have already been terminated anyway.

4 But remaining charge, he's already served  
5 six-and-a-half years. Another 39 days this time  
6 around. I do have a affidavit of dismissal for  
7 that charge.

8 And he's only 38 years old. He was  
9 trying to get a job. He's recently released from  
10 prison, as Agent Cooper just said. But he did  
11 admit missing the admin hearing. He had talked to  
12 Agent Cooper about getting into a residential  
13 facility at that time.

14 He regrets that now. Obviously, he missed  
15 that because that's what he was wanting and needing to  
16 help him get clean, so that's what we're here today,  
17 for Your Honor to consider -- asking you to send him  
18 somewhere for at least six months to a year. I know  
19 the Hope Center Ministries is a year-long program.

20 But he's already on the DSS treatment  
21 plan. Once he's released, he has to go to the  
22 Fatherhood Coalition in order to get custody of  
23 his child back. So he's already got those  
24 requirements of him, so we're asking that you --  
25 if he has to be on house arrest while at the

1 residential facility, we'd ask Your Honor to  
2 consider that. Not send him back, but to let him  
3 get some rehab and give him house arrest.

4 He has done something, Your Honor. He's  
5 paid off all his monies. That's a big  
6 accomplishment.

7 THE COURT: All right. I'm going to go  
8 ahead and let him do the rest of his time. He has  
9 not done what he's supposed to do, so I'm going to  
10 revoke him in full. If he owes you money, reduce  
11 it to civil judgment. Okay?

12 AGENT COOPER: Yes, sir.

13 THE COURT: You have 10 days to appeal  
14 that sentence. Good luck to you.

15 AGENT COOPER: How many days?

16 MR. BRADLEY: Thirty-nine.

17 THE COURT: Recommend ATU on that.

18 AGENT COOPER: Yes, sir.

19 (The hearing was concluded.)

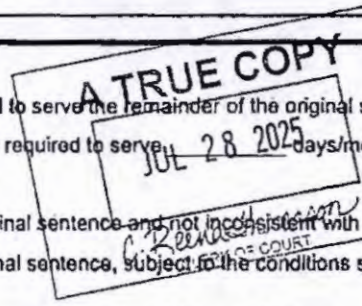

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
