Appellant Tony Williams moves this Court to **STRIKE** the "Response in Opposition" and "Motion for Sanctions" filed March 17, 2026, on the grounds that they are administrative nullities and constitute a fraud upon the Court.

1. FILING BY A STRANGER TO THE RECORD

Pursuant to **Rule 213, SCACR**, only an attorney of record may file motions or papers. Michelle Gaston is not an attorney of record in Case **00079**; no Motion for Substitution has been granted. Her filings are a "Ghost Entry" and must be discarded.

2. LACK OF STANDING (CERTIFIED DEFAULT)

Pursuant to *Thynes v. Lloyd*, 294 S.C. 152 (1987), Respondents are in **Certified Default** and are "out of court." They lack the legal capacity to seek affirmative relief, move for sanctions, or oppose this appeal.

3. IMPROPER SIGNATURE (RULE 11)

Pursuant to **Rule 11, SCRCP** (via Rule 240, SCACR), the filings are not signed by an attorney of record and utilize a middle initial ("E") inconsistent with the Bar registration of the counsel of record in related dockets ("W").

WHEREFORE, Appellant moves to **STRIKE** these unauthorized filings and grant **Summary Reversal** based on the Respondents' admitted liability and systemic extrinsic fraud.
