

**Body-Worn Camera (BWC) and Related Recordings – Flagged Following “Report a Sheriff’s Deputy” Complaint**

**Posture:** Magistrate / Central Court case affirmed by Appeals Judge Thomas McGee III (Order filed 2/27/26 in Court of Common Pleas); appeal to South Carolina Court of Appeals anticipated

Dear Sheriff Lott, Ms. Spurrier, Sergeant Harrison, and Chief McDuffie:

This correspondence serves as a **formal litigation hold / immediate preservation demand** and a **request for access to public records** pursuant to the South Carolina Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”), S.C. Code Ann. § 30-4-10 et seq.

I am the subject of the encounter and the person arrested in Case / Incident No. 2506046515, corresponding to Arrest Warrant Nos. 2025A4010203071 and 2025A4010203072. The underlying Magistrate / Central Court matter was affirmed by Appeals Judge Thomas McGee III by Order filed February 27, 2026, in the Court of Common Pleas. I intend to appeal that ruling to the South Carolina Court of Appeals.

In connection with these matters, I have **filed an online “Report a Sheriff’s Deputy” complaint** with Richland County Sheriff’s Department, and **body-worn camera (BWC) footage has been flagged** in relation to that complaint.

---

**I. IMMEDIATE PRESERVATION DEMAND (LITIGATION HOLD)**

You are hereby placed on notice and **formally demanded to immediately preserve and refrain from altering, deleting, overwriting, destroying, or otherwise spoliating** any and all documents, electronically stored information (ESI), audio, video, photographs, and tangible items related in any way to:

- Case / Incident No. 2506046515;
- Arrest Warrant Nos. 2025A4010203071 and 2025A4010203072;
- All events on June 15–16, 2025, including traffic stop, arrest, transport, and booking;
- All events on July 7, 2025, relating to the Central Court / Traffic Court session and incident outside Courtroom 4;

- All events on August 11, 2025, relating to the Central Court / Traffic Court session and incident outside the Courthouse;
- Any complaints or Internal Affairs / Professional Standards investigations (including but not limited to the online “Report a Sheriff’s Deputy” complaint) involving Deputy **Bryan Hodge**, Deputy Rosa Argueta, Deputy Tim Riley, B. Rhodes, J. Jeffcoat, A. Harris, or any other involved personnel; and
- Any related review, flagging, or handling of body-worn camera (BWC), dash-cam, in-facility camera, transport-vehicle camera, or other recordings.

This demand **includes but is not limited to:**

1. All body-worn camera (BWC) recordings, dash-cam / in-car video, facility cameras, sally-port cameras, and transport-vehicle cameras from June 15–16, 2025, July 7, 2025, and August 11, 2025 involving the above incident and any/all personnel.
2. All digital files, raw and processed video, audio tracks, associated metadata, logs, audit trails, chain-of-custody documentation, download logs, access logs, and any records reflecting flagging or classification of footage (including any “Report a Sheriff’s Deputy” complaint flagging).
3. All incident reports, arrest reports, supplemental reports, booking / jail intake records, and any written or electronic documentation related to the encounter, arrest, and subsequent proceedings from all dates and locations.
4. Any complaints, internal memoranda, internal affairs files, Professional Standards Division records, emails, texts, messaging logs, or other communications referencing or arising from these events or the associated complaint(s).
5. All training materials, policies, SOPs, directives, or memoranda in effect on or about June 15–16, 2025, July 7, 2025, August 11, 2025 and any other dates relating to body-worn cameras, dash cams, evidence handling, complaint handling, and use / release / retention of video.

Destruction, overwriting, or failure to preserve this evidence **after receipt of this notice** constitutes **spoliation of evidence** and may be grounds for **sanctions and adverse inferences** in subsequent judicial proceedings.

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## II. RIGHT OF ACCESS TO BODY-WORN CAMERA FOOTAGE

You are further advised of the following legal principle regarding release of body-worn camera footage to a subject of the recording and officers:

*“Section 10-20-(b)(3) of the Body Camera Act, which, as noted above, provides that footage must be released to ‘the subject of the encounter captured on the recording or to the subject’s attorney, or the officer or his or her legal representative.’*

*As this provision does not hinge on whether footage has been flagged, the AG's office concluded that:*

*'The more reasonable, harmonious construction of section 10-20(b)(3) of the Body Camera Act is that both a subject of the recording and the officer, and their legal representatives, may obtain the recording in accordance with FOIA, regardless of whether or why it has been flagged.'*

I am the **subject of the encounters captured on the recording**, and I hereby invoke my right of access to that footage and related materials **in accordance with FOIA and applicable law**, regardless of whether the footage has been "flagged" in connection with the "Report a Sheriff's Deputy" complaint or any internal process.

2. The signed arrest warrants and any associated returns or documentation reflecting the execution of the warrants.
3. Any probable cause statements, investigative narratives, or other supporting documentation submitted to obtain the warrants.

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
