**APPELLANT'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE INITIAL BRIEF OUT OF TIME**

Appellant Geraldine White, pro se, respectfully moves this Court for leave to file the Appellant's Initial Brief out of time, and in support thereof states as follows:

1. This appeal is presently pending before the South Carolina Court of Appeals.
2. The Court entered an order dated March 16, 2026, directing Appellant to provide a status response regarding the transcript within ten (10) days.
3. Appellant has since confirmed that the transcript was in fact received by the Court of Appeals on February 3, 2026.
