APPELLANT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO SERVE AND FILE MATERIALS PURSUANT TO COURT ORDER

Appellant, Walter R. Hoover, Jr., proceeding pro se, respectfully moves this Court for an extension of time to serve and file the materials requested pursuant to the Court's Order.

Pursuant to this Court's Order, Appellant is required to submit certain materials, including the transcript and APA submissions, by March 28, 2026. Appellant has been diligently working to obtain, review, and prepare these materials for submission in compliance with the Court's directives.

However, an issue has arisen concerning the identification and completeness of the APA materials to be submitted. Multiple versions of the APA submissions exist within the materials provided from the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Commission, and those versions differ in content and pagination. Additionally, the scope of the record appears inconsistent, as materials previously provided reflected approximately 442 pages, while more recent communications from Commission staff indicate the file now exceeds 900 pages.

Appellant is actively working with the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Commission, including coordinating with Amy Bracy, Judicial Director, to confirm and obtain the correct and complete set of materials to ensure accurate compliance with the Court's Order.

In order to ensure that the materials submitted to this Court are complete and accurate, Appellant respectfully requests a brief extension of time. This request is made in good faith and not for purposes of delay, but to ensure the integrity of the record before this Court. Appellant further reserves the right to supplement or seek correction of the Record on Appeal should additional discrepancies be identified.

WHEREFORE, Appellant respectfully requests that this Court grant an extension of ten (10) days, up to and including April 7, 2026, within which to serve and file the requested materials, and for such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.
