MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO

AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for appellant respectfully requests a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension from March 30, 2026, until April 29, 2026**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.

2. Counsel for appellant respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions


previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel will file the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in the case of State v. Michael Stogner, today, March 19, 2026, with the Court of Appeals. Counsel will file the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in the case of State v. Christopher Simpson, today, March 16, 2026, with the Court of Appeals. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Clinton Beebe in the Court of Appeals on March 10, 2026. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix and in the case of Sean Stroman v. State with the Supreme Court on March 9, 2026. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Brandon White with the Court of Appeals on March 6, 2026. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix and in the case of Javon Hair v. State with the Supreme Court on February 19, 2026. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Anthony Overman with the Court of Appeals on February 13, 2026. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix and in the case of Timothy W. Wheeler v. State with the Supreme Court on February 11, 2026. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Charles Murphy with the Court of Appeals on February 5, 2026. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in the case of State v. Deshawn Tollerson with the Court of Appeals on February 5, 2026.


4. On February 26, 2026, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through April 1, 2026.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **fourth and final thirty (30) day extension from March 30, 2026, until April 29, 2026**, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances.
