ORDER

On December 2, 2025, Respondent moved to dismiss this appeal, arguing (1) Appellant's appeal fails to comply with Rules 207, 208, 209, 241, 262, 263, 266, and 269 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules; (2) Appellant failed to serve her notices of appeal, various motions, and other filings before this court as required by the Rules; (3) Appellant seeks to appeal issues not preserved; and (4) the appeal is frivolous. Respondent asked this court to expedite consideration of its motion to dismiss, to sanction Appellant, and to issue remittitur. On January

27, 2026, Appellant filed a return, opposing dismissal. On February 9, 2026, Appellant filed a reply. After careful consideration, we deny Respondent's motion to dismiss. Although the parties argued the merits of the issues on appeal in their filings regarding the motion to dismiss, this order does not address the merits of Appellant's issues on appeal. Further, nothing in this order should be construed as an intent by this court to address motions not properly served.
