Dear Counsel and Mr. Marcus:

On December 31, 2025, this Court mailed the parties a letter regarding appealability and requested memorandum. On March 24, 2026, the letter to Respondent was returned to this Court as undeliverable, as the envelope may have been addressed to a different person at a different correctional facility. Out of an

abundance of caution, we are re-sending the request and re-setting the timeline for filing the memorandum.

We reviewed the order challenged on appeal and determined that it might not be appealable. Respondent must serve and file a memorandum addressing the issue of appealability within ten (10) days of the date of this letter. The Court received Appellant's memorandum on January 23, 2026. The time limits for perfecting the appeal are held in abeyance pending the Court's consideration of the parties' appealability memoranda.
