


accident scene was supporting evidence that the Appellant did not sustain an injury to sustain an award of damages

As this Court has stated in numerous cases, it will presume an affirmance by a Circuit Court of a Magistrate's judgment was made upon the merits where the testimony is sufficient to sustain the judgment of the Magistrate. In the situation at hand, there is no evidence or facts to suggest that the ruling by the Circuit Court for the decision by the jury should be overturned.
