MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE
THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Adrian Vashard Simmons respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, from April 6, 2026 until May 6, 2026**, in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Adrian Vashard Simmons respectfully submits that extraordinary

circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Counsel served as a scoring judge at the Final and Championship rounds of the South Carolina Bar Law Related Education High School Mock Trial Program at the Richland County Central Court on March 13 and 14, 2026. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Keoki Kenta Harris with the Court of Appeals on March 6, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. James Orian Gregory with this Court on March 2, 2026. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Kurtino Weathersbee with the Court of Appeals on February 13, 2026. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of Gerald Jarrod Ancrum v. The State with the Court of Appeals on February 5, 2026.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. On March 30, 2026, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously


