

ORDER

It appears Appellant wishes to appeal from his conviction(s). Appellant filed a motion to exclude proof of service, seeking permission to proceed with his appeal without providing proof of timely service of the notice of appeal. After careful consideration, the motion is denied. Appellant must provide proof of timely service of the notice of appeal, file an amended notice of appeal clarifying the date of sentencing and/or date of the order(s) on appeal along with the date he received written notice of entry of the order if he is appealing something other than his sentence, and provide proof of filing a copy of the notice of appeal with the circuit court clerk of court. Failure to cure each of these deficiencies within 10 days of the date of this order will result in the dismissal of the appeal.
