**APPELLANT'S NOTICE OF PROCEDURAL FINALITY AND  
MANDATORY SUBMISSION TO THE COURT**

**TO: THE CLERK OF THE COURT OF APPEALS:**

The Appellant, Tony Williams, hereby provides formal **Notice of Procedural Finality** regarding all pending motions in the above-captioned appellate tracks.

**1. EXPIRATION OF TIME TO RESPOND:**

Pursuant to **Rule 240, SCACR**, a Respondent has ten (10) days to file a return to a motion. The C-Track Public Index confirms that the Respondents were served with the **Motion to Strike Unauthorized Filings** on **March 19, 2026**.
