

This matter comes before the Court on an Amended Motion to Compel filed by the Plaintiffs in this case.

The Plaintiffs served Interrogatories and Requests to Produce Documents on the Defendant on May 15, 2013 and served a Request to Inspect his house according to Rule 34 in August 2013.

The parties have previously been before the Court on various motions. In July 2013, Judge Hill ordered the Defendant to answer Interrogatories and Requests to Produce Documents within thirty (30) days. Again in August 2013, Judge Stilwell ordered the Defendant to answer the discovery within thirty (30) days. The discovery has not been answered to date.


The Court finds that the Defendant has failed to comply with two Court Orders, failed to comply with the South Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure on appropriately served discovery requests. The Court is reserving sanctions at this time.

The Defendant is ordered to answer the Interrogatories and Requests to Produce Documents within ten (10) days from today's hearing date being October 24, 2013.

The Defendant is further ordered to make his house available for inspection within forty-five days from the date of this Order. Within ten (10) days of the date of this Order, the Defendant will let the Plaintiffs know of any dates that he is not available for the inspection. Thereafter, the Plaintiffs will serve notice for the date of the inspection for himself when one of the Plaintiffs and a third-party and the Plaintiff's attorney can conduct a reasonable inspection which is estimated to take approximately two hours. If a third-party or the Sheriff's Office is needed, they should be involved.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that the Defendant is ordered to comply with the terms of this Order strictly and expeditiously.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
