
Re: State v. Kevin Bennett

This concerns the above case, scheduled for oral argument on December 12 at 10 a.m. Pursuant to Rule 208(b)(7) SCACR, Appellant respectfully wishes to bring this Court's attention the additional authority of State v. Robinson, 310 S.C. 535, 426 S.E.2d 317 (1992) (finding any rational trier of fact could have found all the elements of the crime beyond a reasonable doubt in affirming the denial of a motion for directed verdict and citing Jaskson v. Virginia, 443 U.S. 307 (1979)). Respondent believes this authority is directly relevant to that argument and should be considered by this Court in the instant case.
