**APPELLANT'S MOTION TO CORRECT DOCKET AND TO ENSURE ACCURATE RECORD OF
FILINGS**

Appellant, appearing pro se, respectfully moves this Court to correct the docket and ensure the accurate recording of her filings in this matter.

This motion arises from discrepancies in the docket entries related to Appellant's April 6, 2026 Emergency Motion for Leave to Exceed Page Limit and for Rulings on Pending Motions, and the Court's April 7, 2026 correspondence stating that the appeal is held in abeyance.

1. Omission of Proof of Service of April 6 Motion.

The docket entry for the April 6 Emergency Motion does not include the Proof of Service that was attached to the filing (Exhibit A). Upon filing the Motion with the Proof of Service by email, Appellant received an automated response from the Court containing a stamped copy of the Motion only; the Proof of Service attached to the original filing was not included in the Court's confirmation as a stamped attachment (see Exhibit A).

On April 6, Appellant mailed an additional copy of the Proof of Service to the Court together with the filing fee, which was delivered on April 7, 2026. On April 7, Appellant submitted delivery confirmation of service of the April 6 Motion on Respondent and requested that the Proof of Service be docketed with the Motion (Exhibits B, C). However, the docket entry was updated with the filing fee only and does not reflect the Proof of Service.

2. Incorrect Caption of April 6 Motion.

The April 6 filing appears on the docket as: “Appellant's 2nd Emergency Motion to Supplement 1st Emergency Motion.” This caption does not reflect the title or substance of the Motion, which was filed as: “Appellant’s Emergency Motion for Leave to Exceed Page Limit and for Rulings on Pending Motions” (Exhibit A). The Motion was filed on an emergency basis in light of the imminent April 13 briefing deadline and requests rulings on pending motions necessary to permit preparation of a compliant brief.

3. Clerk’s “Held in Abeyance” Correspondence.

On April 7, the Court issued a letter stating that the appeal is “held in abeyance.” No order modifying the current briefing deadline has been entered. This creates uncertainty as to the status of the April 13, 2026 deadline.

4. Need for Accurate Record.

These discrepancies affect the clarity and accuracy of the procedural record and Appellant’s ability to present and preserve issues for appellate review.

WHEREFORE, Appellant respectfully requests that the Court:

1. Direct that the Proof of Service for the April 6, 2026 Emergency Motion be docketed;
2. Correct the docket caption of the April 6, 2026 filing to accurately reflect its title;
3. Clarify the status of the April 13, 2026 briefing deadline;
4. Grant such other relief as the Court deems just and proper to ensure an accurate and complete record.
