No one bullied me or intimidated me into filing this motion to withdraw. This motion is being filed for the following

REASONS:

- ① The subject property was already supposed to be sold ever since 2024. I have always been in agreement with selling the property. This portion of the judgment is within purview of the original oral agreement we made to sell the property.
- ② Any portion of the judgment can be appealed without stopping the sale of the subject property. Any portion of the judgment can be appealed without stopping the distribution of funds from the sale of the subject property.
