

Upon reviewing your initial brief of appellant and designation of matter, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this matter will be dismissed:

- The initial brief of appellant is not filed in compliance with Rule 208 of the SCACR. You must include a cover page, table of contents, statement of issues on appeal, statement of the case, standard of review, argument, and conclusion in your brief. An example of this format can be found in the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules under Appendix C- Forms, Form 13.
- Your designation of matter cannot contain arguments. The designation of matter should only list documents that parties want included in the record on appeal. An example of this document can be found in the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules under Appendix C- Forms, Form 14.
