Upon reviewing your petition for writ of certiorari, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and the deficiencies must be corrected by May 8, 2026:

- (1) Your petition for a writ of certiorari must comply with the content requirements set forth in Rule 242(d), SCACR, and the form of papers requirements set forth in Rule 268, SCACR. An amended petition that complies with Rules 242 and 268, SCACR, must be filed by May 8, 2026.

- (2) You must provide proof that you served a copy of your petition on opposing counsel.
- (3) You must provide a \$250 filing fee as required by Rule 242(c), SCACR.

All parties to this matter are advised that all filings must comply with the requirements of Rule 242 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). The SCACR are available online at www.sccourts.org/courtreg.

Additionally, any filings submitted by counsel admitted in South Carolina must include counsel's bar number.

The attention of the parties is directed to the order relating to the inclusion of personal data identifiers and other sensitive information in documents filed with the Supreme Court of South Carolina and the South Carolina Court of Appeals. Please note that the responsibility for ensuring that information is redacted or sealed as required by this order rests with counsel and the parties. This office will not review filings for redaction or to determine if materials should be sealed.
