ORDER

Appellant has filed a motion for an extension of time to serve and file the record on appeal because the transcript of the July 12, 2012 hearing has not yet been ordered. Under Rule 207 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Appellant has the burden of ordering the transcript within ten days after the service of the notice of appeal. Furthermore, "[u]nless the parties otherwise agree in writing, [A]ppellant must order a transcript of the entire proceedings below." Rule 207, SCACR. Therefore, it is Appellant's responsibility—not Respondent's—to order this transcript and pay for it. Appellant shall provide this court with proof the transcript has been ordered within ten days. Failure of Appellant to provide proof within ten days will result in the dismissal of this appeal. The request for an extension to serve and file the record on appeal is granted. The record on appeal shall be served and filed within ten days of receipt of the transcript.
