



AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER



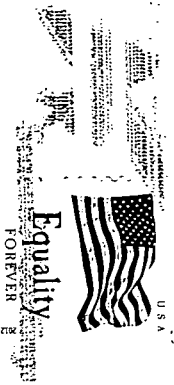
