Dear Mr. Worriax,

Let me please be clear and address the issues you have raised.

First of all, I am no longer your attorney for the purposes of any Appeal. I filed a Notice of Intent to Appeal and perfected your appeal afterwards. So that you could Appeal if that was your desire.

Second, you never asked me to get a fingerprint expert as you told me that you had been in that house on multiple occasions and that the print could have been yours. You did however say that you never touched her bloody body. You also told me that you had helped her by bringing out water in the house that day and that you and she had sex the night before the body was found.

Third, I agree you are probably making up lies now.

Fourth, it was the lie between you and Travis that likely got you convicted, as to when you were dropped off and when you were picked up on the jail call.
