

## ORDER

On October 3, 2013, this court held the above-captioned appeal in abeyance and remanded the case to the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Commission to determine whether there exists a binding agreement between the parties to settle Respondent's claim. We ordered the Commission to make a written determination and report its findings to this court within thirty days. Subsequently, this court granted the Commission's request for an extension of time to comply with the order by November 18, 2013. However, the matter is still pending before the Commission.


We now order the Commission to set a hearing date, with thirty days' notice to the parties, for the purpose of making written findings of fact and conclusions of law regarding whether a binding settlement agreement exists.
