Appeals to the Appellate Court

Plaintiff filed in Forma Pauperis, and sent a financial state showing a negative balance of \$382.26 to the Clerk of Court: Jeanette McBride, of Richland County. Plaintiff has to pay restitution and therefore could not pay \$150 for the claim. Ms. McBride waited until Plaintiff was supposed to have a mediation with defendants. Then got a Judge whose code is 2774 to sign off saying the case was closed for not pay the \$150. This was done at the end night before mediation.

This case was closed with prejudice, and biasness for the Defendants. Had Ms. McBride said this from the beginning instead of giving a (30) thirty day notice, Plaintiff might have been able to pay the fee but was not given ~~an~~ ample notice time.

Filing In Forma Pauperis: "A presumption that Plaintiff is unable to pay the fee required to file the action shall be created if the Plaintiff's net household income is less than equal to the ~~poverty~~ guidelines established and revised annually. Net Income shall mean gross income minus deduction allowed by law.

Plaintiff filed appeal 1/23/26 to no avail, and has not heard anything from the Clerk of Court for Richland County, Jeanette McBride.
