ORDER

The parties have filed a consent motion to remand this matter to the circuit court for further proceedings. The parties agree that (a) Respondent's claims against Appellants are subject to the mandatory ADR provisions set forth in Section 9.1 of the April 1, 2020 Physician Employment Agreement (PEA); (b) Respondent and Appellants shall comply with the mandatory ADR provisions set forth in Section 9.6 of the PEA as to the claims set forth in this matter; and (c) the circuit court matter shall be stayed as to Appellants only pursuant to Rule 26(c), SCRCP, and Article 3 of the Federal Arbitration Act. Neither party shall seek costs pursuant to Rule 222, SCACR.

After careful consideration, the motion is granted. The appeal is dismissed and remanded to the circuit court for consideration of the parties' agreement and such action as is necessary. The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
