ORDER

On March 17, 2026, Respondents filed a motion for sanctions, arguing Appellant's conduct throughout the appeal "demonstrated a persistent disregard for the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules and a pattern of filings that serve only to burden the Court and opposing counsel." Respondents further argue that Appellant's filings were frivolous and rested on authorities that did not exist or that Appellant materially misrepresented. Appellant did not file a return.

After consideration, we deny Respondents' motion for sanctions. However, nothing prohibits Respondents from seeking costs incurred in defending against the referenced conduct pursuant to Rule 222 of the Appellate Court Rules.
