Comes now, APPELLANT BURR, AND SUBMITS DOCUMENTATION IN SUPPORT OF HIS APPEAL, SUCH AS SENTENCING ORDERS, WARRANTS E.T.C. AND ALSO INFORMS THIS HONORABLE COURT OF APPEALS THE FOLLOWING:

I.

APPELLANT WAS RUSHED INTO COURT ON FEBRUARY 3RD 2026, JUDGE DEBRA MCCASKIN WAS PRESIDED, SHE STOPPED THE ENTIRE COURT THAT DAY AND AIMED, PRETTY MUCH TO APPELLANT. SHE SAID THAT APPELLANT WOULD PLEAD GUILTY OR SHE WAS GOING TO ORDER A JURY TRIAL, RIGHT THEN AND THERE. APPELLANT'S ATTORNEY DID ABSOLUTELY NOTHING, SHE THREATENED HIM, THIS WAS APPELLANT'S FIRST APPEARANCE. APPELLANT FURTHER STATES HE HAS NEVER SEEN A COURT TRIAL CASE, WHERE THE DEFENSE ATTORNEY NEVER SAID (1) WORD OR (1) SPECK OF EVIDENCE, NEVER, NOT EVEN ON T.V.

APPELLANT INFORMED BALIFF, OFFICER PERRY, HE INFORMED ATTORNEY ARTHUR K. AIKEN, THAT BECAUSE THE SHERIFF AND CORONER CONFISCATED BURR'S WIFE, TOOK POSSESSION OF HER ILLEGALLY, THEN CREATED HER WITHOUT NOTICE, AND OF COURSE, A FEDERAL LAWSUIT (PENDING) FOLLOWED. APPELLANT WAS NOT IN ANY TROUBLE DURING THAT TIME 1-26-25 (HER DEATH) (H-17-25) ALL THIS WENT DOWN. BURR'S WIFE IS/WAS A VIETNAM ERA, U.S. ARMY-HONORABLE SERVICE CONNECTED, VETERAN, THEY DID THAT BECAUSE BURR FIGHTS BACK, TILL THIS DAY THEY STILL WILL NOT SURRENDER WIFE'S REMAINS OVER, EVERYTIME BURR FIGHTS BACK, HERE THEY COME AGAIN, IF THE COURT WILL NOTICE EXHIBITS A + B (ATTACHED) EVEN THE CLERK OF COURT WAITED NEARLY 2 WEEKS TO FILE THOSE EXHIBITS (SEE FILESTAMP DATE, NOW DATE APPELLATE SENT THEM).

II

APPELLANT INFORMS COURT OF APPEALS THAT WHEN THE PLEA-BARGAIN BEGAN ON FEBRUARY 3RD 2026, IT CONSISTED OF (6) CHARGES, HOWEVER THE APPELLANT, HALF THROUGH, TOLD THE JUDGE HE COULD NOT CONTINUE, HE WAS TOO UNSTABLE, BROKEN TO PIECES OVER HIS WIFE, AND NEEDED MENTAL HEALTH

APPELLANT HAD BEEN TRYING TO GO FOR 7 MONTHS, WHILE UNDER EXCESSIVE BAIL, BUT NURSE PAM AT THE JAIL REFUSED, SO APPELLANT TOLD JUDGE HE NEEDED MORE TIME, SO JUDGE SAID "BE BACK HERE AT COURT AT 10 AM ON FRIDAY FEBRUARY 6TH 2026, HOWEVER PLAINTIFF'S DOCTOR IMMEDIATELY PUT APPELLANT IN MENTAL HEALTH ON 5TH 6TH 9TH FOLLOWED PROTOCOL, POLICE AMBULANCE CARRIED APPELLANT TO HOSPITAL, HOWEVER APPELLANT USED HIS (1) PHONE CALL TO CALL OFFICER PAT KELLY AT CHESTERFIELD COUNTY SHERIFFS DEPT, SHE SAID "OKAY I'LL LET THEM KNOW," THEN ON THE FRIDAY, THE 6TH, APPELLANT CALLED HIS ATTORNEY AROUND 8 AM, INFORMED HIM, HE SAID "I'LL TAKE CARE OF IT," HE DIDN'T CALL OR SHOW UP, AND APPARENTLY THE JUDGE AND PROSECUTOR PROCEEDED WITHOUT APPELLANT, HOWEVER IF THIS HONORABLE COURT OF APPEAL WILL LOOK AT EXHIBIT C AND D ATTACHED YOU WILL SEE THIS.

ON FEBRUARY 3RD 2026, THE PLEA-BARGAIN WAS NOT COMPLETED THE ORIGINAL PLAN WAS PLEAD GUILTY ON THE TRAFFICKING AND APPELLANT WOULD GET TIME SERVED, RAN CONCURRENT ON ALL THE OTHER CHARGES, HOWEVER, WITH APPELLANT NOT ABLE TO SHOW, ATTORNEY DIDN'T SHOW, BURR FIRED HIM LATER, THE STATE FINALIZED THE PLEA-BARGAIN AND LEFT (2) CHARGES OUT, TRYING TO BE SNEAKY, NOW THAT APPELLANT KNOWS, (SEE EXHIBIT C + D), THEY WROTE N/P ON 2-6-26, SOMEONE SIGNED (1) OF THE (2) EXHIBIT (D), BUT YOU CAN'T TELL, BUT IT WAS AFTER THE CLERK'S FILE STAMP (SEE EXHIBITS C + D), AND ON THE OTHERS, YOU CAN SEE THE DARKNESS OF APPELLANT'S ATTORNEY'S PEN, COMPARED TO THE CLERKS AND COURT REPORTER'S LIGHTER PEN. 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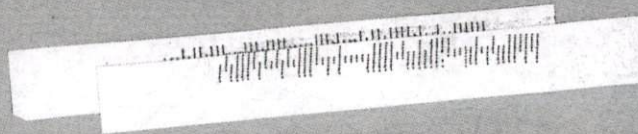
