




ORDER

Petitioner filed a notice of appeal from the dismissal of his application for post-conviction relief (PCR) and an explanation as required by Rule 243(c), SCACR. In his Rule 243(c) explanation, Petitioner has failed to show there is an arguable basis for asserting that the dismissal of his PCR application was improper.
