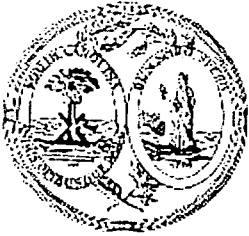

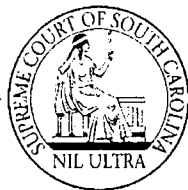

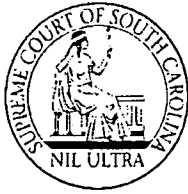

Dear Mr. Rochester:

This will acknowledge receipt of your correspondence. Be advised that you do not currently have an appeal pending in this Court. According to Rule 203 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, a Notice of Appeal must include the name of the court from which the appeal is taken; the judge's name; the lower court docket number; the date of the order being appealed; the name of the appealing party; and the names, mailing addresses, and telephone numbers of all the attorneys of record and the names of the party or parties represented by each. A copy of the order being challenged on appeal, proof of service showing the notice has been timely served on all respondents, and a filing fee of \$100.00 must accompany the Notice of Appeal.

If you intend to proceed with an appeal pro se, the fact that you are not an attorney does not relieve you of the responsibility to perfect your appeal in accordance with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
