ORDER

Pursuant to Rule 203(b)(2) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), an appeal from the Court of General Sessions must be served on all respondents within ten days of the imposition of the sentence. The proof of service provided to the Court indicates that the notice of appeal was served on the State on August 16, 2013. The trial court imposed a sentence upon the appellant on July 18, 2013. This appeal was not timely served; accordingly, the appeal is dismissed. *See Hill v. South Carolina Dept. of Health & Env'tl Control*, 389 S.C. 1, 21, 698 S.E.2d 612, 623 (2010) ("The service of a notice of appeal is a jurisdictional requirement, and the time for service may not be extended by this Court."). Remittitur shall be sent according to Rule 221(b), SCACR.
