**ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF APPEAL**

This matter comes before the Court upon Appellant Geraldine White’s Motion to Reinstate Appeal and Supplemental Notice advising the Court that the filing fee was timely paid but appears to have been administratively applied to the incorrect appellate case number.

Upon review of the motion, supplemental notice, and supporting documentation, including proof of payment of the \$250.00 filing fee, Receipt No. 107821, and documentation reflecting that the payment was applied to Case No. 2026-000660 rather than Appellate Case No. 2025-002484, the Court finds that the dismissal of Appellate Case No. 2025-002484 resulted from clerical or administrative error and not from Appellant’s failure to pay the filing fee.

Accordingly, it is hereby:

ORDERED that Appellant’s Motion to Reinstate Appeal is GRANTED;

ORDERED that the dismissal of Appellate Case No. 2025-002484 is VACATED;

ORDERED that Appellate Case No. 2025-002484 is REINSTATED nunc pro tunc as of the date of dismissal;

ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall correct the record to reflect that Appellant’s \$250.00 filing fee was timely paid and shall apply said filing fee to Appellate Case No. 2025-002484; and

ORDERED that all appellate deadlines shall be recalculated or restored in a manner that preserves Appellant’s rights and prevents prejudice resulting from the clerical or administrative error.
