Statute of Limitations

This Constitutional violation occurred in 1976 when the 7th Circuit ^{DRS. Claude Taylor} Solicitor, at the time, altered the charge of Robbery to Armed Robbery, which was unlawful! No one has the authority to change the charge on a Grand Jury indictment except the Grand Jury who handed it down. These tragic consequences of this unlawful action by Solicitor Taylor continues to affect my life today!
