EMERGENCY REQUEST FOR IMMEDIATE HEARING

(Regarding Emergency Motion to Stay Writ of Ejectment)

COMES NOW the Defendant, Barbara Hannah Rogers, pro se, and respectfully requests an **immediate emergency hearing** on her previously filed Emergency Motion to Stay Writ of Ejectment.

In support of this request, Defendant states:

1. A **Sheriff's set-out (eviction)** is scheduled for **May 12, 2026 at 10:00 AM**, placing Defendant at immediate risk of losing her home and all personal property.
2. Defendant has filed an **Emergency Motion to Stay Writ of Ejectment**, which is currently pending before this Court.
3. Defendant was **never properly served** with the foreclosure complaint and proceedings, constituting a **violation of due process rights under the Fourteenth Amendment**.
4. Defendant has filed a **Notice of Appeal and Designation of Record**, and the matter is currently under appellate review.
5. If the eviction proceeds before the Court rules, Defendant will suffer **irreparable harm**, including displacement, loss of property, and severe emotional distress.
6. Equity and justice require that the Court **stay the eviction immediately** until the due process violations and appeal are properly reviewed.
