Dear Mr. Rochester:

We have received your letters dated October 30, 2013, and November 21, 2013. As noted in this Court's October 30, 2013 letter, we do not currently have an appeal pending in this Court in your name. We did not construe the document you filed as a notice of appeal. Upon review of the voluminous documents included in your November 21, 2013 filing, we will construe the document entitled "Intent to Appeal" as a new notice of appeal. However, there are numerous deficiencies in this notice of appeal. You must correct the deficiencies listed below within ten days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed.

- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$100.00.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Your proof of service must include the date you served the notice of appeal on the opposing parties to the appeal. The proof of service

should also include the names of parties served and addresses where they were served.

- The notice of appeal should be amended to remove your arguments. This is not the appropriate time to submit your arguments to the Court. Please provide a proof of service for the amended notice of appeal that you file.
- You have included documents with your notice of appeal that are not necessary at this time. These documents are being returned to you.
