
Dear Mr. Gray:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this matter will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Pursuant to Rule 262(c)(3), SCACR, and Re: Methods of Electronic Filing & Service Under Rule 262 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, S.C. Sup. Ct. Order dated May 6, 2022, only lawyers admitted to practice in South Carolina may serve other lawyers using the lawyer's primary email address in AIS. Pro se appellants must serve the respondent's attorneys via USPS mail.

- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$250.00.

- The notice of appeal has not been signed as required by Rule 267(b), SCACR.
- You must provide proof of filing the notice of appeal with the Lexington County Clerk of Court.
