MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE  
THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI  
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Daryl Quarles respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, from May 6, 2026, until June 5, 2026**, in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Daryl Quarles respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of

extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of Anthony Briggs v. The State with the Court of Appeals on April 2, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Joint Appendix in the case of Christopher Ray Smith v. The State with the Supreme Court on March 31, 2026. Counsel filed the Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the case of Darius T. Cathcart v. The State with the Supreme Court on March 25, 2026. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Toby Khan Armstrong with the Court of Appeals on March 23, 2026. Counsel filed the Anders Brief of Appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of The State v. Derrick Edward Gathers with the Court of Appeals on March 11, 2026. Counsel filed the Record on Appeal and Final Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Mustafa A. Salaam with the Court of Appeals on March 9, 2026.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


