10 AGENT GRAHAM: May it please the Court? Your Honor,
11 Courtney Register was sentenced in Florence County, General
12 Sessions Court on August 17th, 2023, under indictment Number
13 2023-GS-21-02097 for forgery by Your Honor. On May the 8th,
14 the defendant reported as instructed and signed a restitution
15 -- signed an order to restructure her restitution and
16 surcharge account. Two hundred credits were revoked to allow
17 her more time to pay on her account. She has a balance of
18 \$603.63 in court costs, 263 in restitution, and is currently
19 \$300 in arrears with a balance of 800 in supervision fees.

20 The defendant has refused to comply since June of 2025.

21 On October the 6th, AIC Elliott and I visited the jail to
22 explain that she remained on probation and to request a urine
23 sample due to multiple community complaints alleging drug use.
24 The defendant refuses to comply.

25 Agent -- we also attempted to explain the administrative

1 hearing that she is speaking about that happened in 2017 in
2 Florence. A home visit was conducted on October the 15th. I
3 left reporting instructions for her to come to the office on
4 October the 16th. She failed to comply.

5 Your Honor, we have exhausted all attempts to get Ms.
6 Register to comply. The state is recommending revocation.
7 She has served a total of seven days at the Marion County
8 Detention Center.

9 THE COURT: All right.

10 Yes, sir?

11 MR. MEETZ: Your Honor, she does admit that she failed to
12 report as instructed. Certainly, she admits that that is a
13 willful violation of her probation. Judge, she's had
14 transportation issues and wasn't able to make it.

15 As far as the other, financially, Judge, she hasn't been
16 working, and she's currently -- she indicates to me she has a
17 lawyer that's representing her on a disability case. She's
18 got severe ADHD as well as some significant back issues, and
19 she does have an attorney, according to her, and I think
20 Steven Calcutt is who she indicates her lawyer is representing
21 her with regard to her disability issue, so that has made it
22 difficult for her to work and pay the financial
23 responsibilities.

24 Judge, she tells me as part of the allegations that she
25 was arrested on, two separate dates, one in July for a

1 magistrate level malicious injury to property. She tells me
2 she did not get arrested for that. I don't know. I haven't
3 -- you know, the city court stuff, we can't really look it up,
4 so I don't know. She was arrested on a controlled substance
5 possession charge, which she says when tested will come back
6 as heart pills of her mothers. So, obviously that's an
7 October arrest. There won't be a drug report back in that for
8 a while. But anyway, that's what she tells me there.

9 So, Judge, she was put on probation in 2023. Her only
10 prior violations were both in 2025. Both the same day and
11 both were with regards to failure to seek to have gainful
12 employment. But she's been dealing with these issues that
13 have -- that she's now dealing with as far as the disability
14 claim goes. Other than that, it looks like she did very well
15 for a large part of two years of probation from 2023 until we
16 have these issues now.

17 Judge, obviously, she understands that with failing to
18 report she has violated probation, even though they did do
19 home visits as the agent indicated. We'd just asking for
20 whatever mercy you believe to be appropriate. We'd ask the
21 Court to consider continuing her on probation, but if not,
22 Judge, to revoke an amount of time that maybe she could do
23 here in Marion County. But otherwise, Judge, whatever you
24 believe to be appropriate.

25 THE COURT: Who does she owe the restitution to?

1. I shall report in person to the South Carolina Department of Probation, Parole and Pardon Services' office on the day of my sentencing or release, and as instructed by the Department, and I shall make complete and truthful reports to the Agent.
2. I shall not change my residence or employment without the consent of my Agent. Further, I shall allow my Agent to visit me in my home, at my place of employment, or elsewhere, at any time.
3. I shall not use controlled substances, except when properly prescribed by a licensed physician, nor consume alcoholic beverages to excess, nor enter establishments whose primary business is the sale and drinking of alcoholic beverages. Further, I shall submit to a urinalysis, blood test or provide forensic evidence when instructed by Agents of the Department, and I agree that any of these test results may be used as evidence in any hearing for the violation of the conditions of my supervision.
4. I shall not possess or purchase any firearms or other dangerous weapons, and I shall not associate with any person who has a criminal record, or any other person whom my Agent has instructed me to avoid.
5. I shall work diligently at a lawful occupation. Further, I shall notify my Agent if I become unemployed.
6. I shall not violate any Federal, State, or Local Law, and I shall immediately contact my Agent if I am ever arrested or questioned by a law enforcement official for any reason whatsoever.

8. I shall not leave the State without permission from my Agent. Further, if I am ever arrested in another state for violating these conditions, I hereby irrevocably waive all extradition rights I may otherwise have been entitled to and agree to return to South Carolina when directed by my Agent, the Court or by a warrant.


