MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE

Counsel for James Bubba Patterson respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, from May 8, 2026, until June 8, 2026**, in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Kenya R. Jenkins v. The State with the Supreme Court on April 10, 2026. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Quindaris K. Washington with the Court of Appeals on April 8, 2026. Counsel had an oral argument in The State v. Justin Cole Carroll in the Court of Appeals on April 8, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of The State v. Jason Barry Bell with the Court of Appeals on April 1, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Jaquese Kavon Hyatt v. The State with the Supreme Court on March 17, 2026. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Darryl Jerome Washington with the Court of Appeals on March 9, 2026. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and accompanying Appendix in the case of Pamela Michelle Tackett v. The State with the Supreme Court on March 2, 2026. Counsel spoke at the Criminal Practice CLE in Columbia on February 27, 2026. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of Jason Ervin Black v. The State with the Supreme Court on February 26, 2026.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


