Dear Mr. Poinsette:

I have received your request of the trial transcript from the above referenced trial, held in Dorchester between August 11-13, 2025. The standard timeframe for transcript delivery is 60 days, which I can certainly do. The rate for the completed transcript is \$4.25 per page. While I do not know at this time enough of the scope of the work to provide you with an estimate of total costs, I do know that it will be over \$100, so I will require a non-refundable deposit of that amount in order to begin the work. Once I receive that deposit, I will begin, and that is also when the 60 days begins. During that time, I of course, will keep you apprised of the progress, and I will be able to provide a more accurate estimation of the final total as I get closer to completion.

I understand that you are currently indigent, and I can certainly understand that you are unable to provide payment at this time. However, I cannot produce the transcript without payment. I would encourage you to contact the South Carolina Commission of Indigent Defense to see if they might be able to help you, as that is the mission of that office. If you choose not to contact them, then I will need a deposit to begin the work on the transcript, as mentioned above, with payment in full to be received prior to delivery of the transcript.
