

ORDER

On December 29, 2025, Appellant filed a notice of appeal of an Administrative Law Court order remanding to the South Carolina Department of Corrections for Appellant to "calculate and offer to remit to [Respondent] the additional pay owed to [Respondent] under the prevailing wage statute." Upon receiving the notice of appeal, this court requested memoranda from the parties regarding the appealability of the order. After carefully considering both parties' memoranda, it appears the order is subject to immediate appeal. However, this order merely allows the appeal to proceed at this time and does not finally determine whether the underlying order is subject to immediate review.¹
