Dear Mr. Jenkins:

Upon reviewing your designation of matter and attachments filed on May 6, 2026, which this Court construes as an attempt to file the record on appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this matter will be dismissed:

- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The document is improperly paginated. Specifically, the record on appeal must be numbered consecutively beginning with the index pursuant to Rule 210(c), SCACR.
- The caption does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the caption must match exactly with the one given below. You must serve and file a record on appeal that complies with Rule 210, SCACR, and that is substantially in the format shown by Form 15 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
