ORDER

Appellant moves to exclude certain matters from the record on appeal in this matter. Appellant also requests that he be allowed to file one unbound copy and five bound copies of the record on appeal and to submit the remaining copies by disc in PDF format. The State opposes the motion to exclude, but takes no position on the request to submit a certain number of copies of the record in electronic format. The motion to exclude is granted as to page 12 of the July 2007 transcript, but denied as to the remaining items. Appellant may file one unbound copy and *six* bound copies of the record on appeal and submit the remaining copies in electronic format as proposed. The State shall be provided with a hard copy and an electronic copy of the record.
