

ORDER

On April 27, 2026, Appellant filed a motion requesting "a cost waiver on the expedited transcript request order." Appellant stated it had ordered the transcript 318 days prior to its motion being filed, Court Administration had approved the maximum allowable extensions to produce the transcript, and the matter had subsequently been reassigned to a subcontractor—Legal Eagle. Appellant explained however, that in order to avoid further delay, it believed a request to expedite the transcript with the subcontractor was appropriate and thus was moving before this court for a waiver of the cost to expedite the transcription.

After careful consideration, we deny Appellant's motion requesting this court to waive Legal Eagle's cost to expedite the transcript.
