**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE
APPELLANT’S INITIAL BRIEF AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER**

Pursuant to Rule 240(a) SCACR, Appellant Jill T. Evans hereby request that the Court grant a thirty (30) day extension in which to file her Initial Brief and Designation of Matter in the above-captioned matter. Currently, Appellant’s Initial Brief and Designation of Matter was due thirty (30) days after delivery of the Transcript. On April 12, 2026 (a Sunday), counsel received an e-mail from madame Court Reporter with an invoice for the Transcript; however, having viewed the e-mail from his cellular phone, did not realize that a .PDF copy of the Transcript itself was also attached. Opposing counsel advised via e-mail today, May 20, 2026, that he had received a .PDF copy of the Transcript on April 12, 2026. 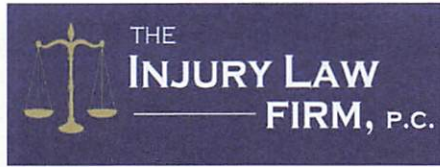
